## STOP! Before Beginning Assembly!



Do not start assembly until you have read all instructions.

Only adults should set up the play equipment. Do not allow children in the setup area until assembly is complete.

# \*\*IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION\*\* PLEASE READ BEFORE BEGINNING ASSEMBLY:

#### Installation and Ground Preparation Instructions:

- Place the equipment on level, well-drained ground, not less than 6 ft. (1.8 m) from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines, or electrical wires.
- Do not install home playground equipment over concrete, asphalt, packed earth, or any other hard surface. A fall onto a hard surface can result in serious injury to the equipment user (see page 7).
- Install the playground equipment with the slide facing North, this helps prevent the surface on the slide from getting too hot.
- To prevent serious injury, warn children that they must not use the equipment until properly installed.
- With unstable soil conditions, we recommend anchoring the playset into the ground. Call our Customer Service Department at 1-800-225-3865 for more information.

#### Operating Instructions:


Observing the following instructions and warnings reduces the likelihood of serious or fatal injury.

- The maximum number of occupants that may safely use the entire playset including all components is 20 with a maximum weight of 2000 pounds.
- On-site adult supervision should be provided for children of all ages.
- Instruct children not to walk close to, in front of, behind, or between moving items.
- Instruct children not to twist swing chains or ropes or loop them over the top support bar since this may reduce the strength of the chain or rope.
- · Instruct children to avoid swinging empty seats.
- Teach children to sit in the center of the swings with their full weight on the seats.
- Instruct children not to use the equipment in a manner other than intended.
- Instruct children not to get off equipment while it is in motion.
- To prevent entanglement and strangulation, dress children appropriately using well-fitting shoes and avoiding ponchos, scarves, jackets with neck drawstrings, helmets with straps, and other loose-fitting clothing that is potentially hazardous while using equipment.
- Instruct children not to climb when the equipment is wet.
- Instruct children not to attach items to the playground equipment that are not specifically designed for use with the equipment, such as, but not limited to, jump ropes, clothesline, pet leashes, cables and chain as they may cause a strangulation hazard.

#### Maintenance Instructions:

- Check surfacing material and replenish as necessary to maintain proper depth (see page 7).
- Check all nuts and bolts twice monthly during the usage season for tightness and tighten as required. It is particularly important that this procedure be followed at the beginning of each season.
- · Remove any tripping hazards, such as exposed concrete footings, tree stumps, or rocks.
- Oil all metallic moving parts monthly during the usage period.
- Check all coverings for bolts and sharp edges twice monthly during usage season to be certain they are in place. Replace when necessary. It is especially important to do this at the beginning of each new season.
- Check swing seats, ropes, cables and chains monthly during usage season for evidence of deterioration. Contact Customer Service for replacement parts.
- Sand rusted areas on tubular members and repaint using a nonlead-based paint (included with system).
- Take plastic swing seats indoors or do not use when the temperature drops below 40 degrees F.
- If the warning sticker is illegible, destroyed or removed, contact Customer Service for a replacement. **Disposal Instructions:** Disassemble and dispose of the playground equipment in such a way that no unreasonable hazards will exist at the time the swing set is discarded. Follow all local disposal requirements.

Place the equipment no less than 6 ft. (1.8 m) from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines, or electrical wires. Make sure the clearance in front of and behind the swings is at least twice the height of the swing bar. The impact surfacing needs to cover the entire recommended play area. Refer to the example below.



#### CONSUMER INFORMATION SHEET FOR PLAYGROUND SURFACING MATERIALS\*

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) estimates that about 100,000 playground equipment related injuries resulting from falls to the ground surface are treated annually in U.S. hospital emergency rooms. Injuries involving this hazard pattern tend to be among the most serious of all playground injuries, and have the potential to be fatal, particularly when the injury is to the head. The surface under and around playground equipment can be a major factor in determining the injury causing potential of a fall. It is self evident that a fall onto a shock-absorbing surface is less likely to cause a serious injury than a fall onto a hard surface. Playground equipment should never be placed on hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt and while grass may appear to be acceptable, it may quickly turn to hard packed earth in areas of high traffic. Shredded bark mulch, wood chips, fine sand or fine gravel are considered to be acceptable shock-absorbing surfaces when installed and maintained at a sufficient depth under and around playground equipment.

Table 1 lists the maximum height from which a child would not be expected to sustain a life-threatening head injury in a fall onto different loose-fill surfacing materials if they are installed and maintained at

depths of 6, 9, and 12 inches. However, it should be recognized that all injuries due to falls cannot be prevented no matter what surfacing material is used.

It is recommended that a shock-absorbing material should extend a minimum of 6 ft. in all directions from the perimeter of stationary equipment such as climbers and slides. However, because children may deliberately jump from a moving swing, the shock absorbing material should extend in the front and rear of a swing a minimum distance of 2 times the height of the pivot point measured from a point directly beneath the pivot on the supporting structure.

This information is intended to assist in comparing the relative shock-absorbing properties of various materials. No particular material is recommended over another. However, each material is only effective when properly maintained. Materials should be checked periodically and replenished to maintain correct depth as determined necessary for your equipment. The choice of a material depends on the type and height of the playground equipment, the availability of the material in your area, and its cost.



# USING A DRILL IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR DRIVING BOLTS.

A cordless drill can be used for driving screws; however, care should be taken not to over tighten or strip screws.

If you decide to use a drill for driving bolts, follow the tips to reduce the chance of damaging the product:

- 1. Always start bolts by hand to prevent cross-threading.
- 2. Use a drill with the clutch set at the lowest setting that will drive the bolts.
- 3. Use an Allen wrench for final tightening of bolt to prevent over-tightening.




Attach Cross Braces (F) between the Bottom Short D-Tube (E) and the Corner Poles (A). Secure with the hardware shown.

Do not tighten the hardware--the Bolts attaching the Cross Braces to the D-Tube will be shared with another part later in the assembly.



Repeat steps 1 and 2 to assemble the other Short D-Tubes (D, E) to the Corner Poles (A), and to attach the Cross Braces (F) to the Corner Poles (A) and the Short Bottom D-Tube (E).






Carefully stand up the assembled Short Ends of the Clubhouse.


Attach the Bottom Long D-Tubes (C) to one of the assembled short ends, while the other end of the D-Tube remains on the ground. The flat sides of the D-Tubes should face up, and the holes in the D-Tubes should face in.















Attach Cross Braces (F) on both of the Long Bottom D-Tubes (C) as shown in step 2.

Note: The location of the Railings will depend on which accessories were purchased, and their desired placement. The 2 Piece Railings go on each corner of the Clubhouse, and the 4 Piece Railings go in the middle of each long side. The 5 Piece Railings can move between the open spots to allow for accessories. All open spots without an accessory must be filled with a Railing, as well as the side with the Swing Bar.









Install 2 Piece Railings (J) on both ends of long side of the Clubhouse. Place a 4 Piece Railing (K) and a 5 Piece Railing (L) between them in the location shown. Refer back to the previous steps to secure the Railings with the hardware shown. The Railings will share hardware where they overlap.

If a Climbing Wall was not purchased, another 5 Piece Railing will be included. Install it in the spot left open.



Secure the top Bolts of the Railings before attaching the bottom of the Railings. Do not overtighten the hardware that attaches the bottom of the Railings through the Deck.

Install the remaining 2 Piece Railing (J) on to the last corner of the Clubhouse. Refer back to the previous steps to secure the Railing with the hardware shown.




# The Monkey Bar is not intended to be a stand alone unit. Do not use until completely attached to the main unit as instructed.






Place Cradle Caps (HF) between the Monkey Bar Ladder (B) and the Monkey Bar Rungs (A). Secure the Brackets (C) to the Ladder (B) with the hardware shown. Tighten all the hardware evenly to avoid gaps. One person should hold the Ladder (B) while the other attaches the hardware.



Repeat this step to attach the Monkey Bar Ladder on the other side of the Monkey Bar Rungs.





Carefully turn the Monkey Bar assembly upright and set it up in the desired location by the Clubhouse.



### **WARNING**



The Monkey Bar is not stable until attached to the Clubhouse with a Swing Bar. Do not use until completely attached to the main unit as instructed.









Carefully tilt one end of the Monkey Bar assembly and install two Foot Caps (HD), and then repeat for the other end of the Monkey Bars. Insert Hole Caps (HC) into the holes at the bottom of the Monkey Bar Ladders (B). If using the leveling kit, use the holes to attach the extensions.

Attach the Monkey Bars to the Clubhouse according to the instructions in section 3.








